- Note 1 The event fee must be paid and received at the Scout Service Center by the "**Registration Due Date**" to avoid a late fee.
- Note 2 A late fee of \$5.00 is added to the event fee for every registration received at the Scout Service Center from the registration due date through the Monday immediately preceding the event.
- Note 3 A late fee of \$10.00 is added to the event fee for every registration received at the Scout Service Center from the Tuesday immediately preceding the event until the date of the event. The same \$10.00 late fee will be applied for walk-ins at the event and for telephone registrations.
- Note 4 Submit the Brotherhood fee only if you have been an Ordeal member for a minimum of 10 months and you intend to seal your membership in the Order of the Arrow.
- Note 5 Refunds will not be issued unless a written request is received at the Colonial Virginia Council Scout Service Center by 5:00 pm on the Tuesday immediately preceding the event.
- Note 6 Submit the signed Boy Scout Medical Form with the registration form the first time an OA member registers for an OA event in 2010. These forms will be kept until the end of the calendar year when they will be destroyed.
- Note 7 Uniforms are required for ceremonies, Saturday night dinner, Sunday morning breakfast, and business meetings.
